

he Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) said that one of the supplications of Prophet Dāwūd (peace be upon him) was that he would say, "
قَامُنَا اللَّهُمَّ إِنِي أَسْأَلُكَ حُبَّكَ, O Allah I ask You for Your love, وَحُبَّ مَنْ يُحِبُّكَ, and the love of those who love You, وَالْعُمَلَ الَّذِي يُبَلِّغُنِي حُبَّكَ, and all of the actions that would bring me closer to being loved by You."

Our aim should constantly be to pursue Allah's pleasure; pursue the reward that He has promised. The most frequent references in the Qur'an to the love of Allah come in relation to taqwā, piety.

Surah al-Baqarah starts with this beautiful āyah:
الم. ذَلِكَ الْكِتَابُ لاَ رَيْبَ فِيهِ هُدًى لِّلْهُتَّقِينَ

Alif. Lam. Mim. This is a Book in which there is no doubt, it is a guidance for people of taqwā.

People of taqwā, people of piety, are the ones Allah loves. He says in the Qur'an: فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ يُحِبُّ الْمُتَّقِينَ And Allah loves the people of piety.
